preparatory college or a comparable institution. You do not necessarily have to submit an admission letter for this.

- You have been admitted to part-time study by a state university, a state-recognized university or a comparable educational institution.
- you have been accepted to take part in a preparatory language course without having already been admitted by a higher education institution.
- you have been accepted by a company to complete an internship in preparation for your studies.

When deciding whether to issue your residence permit, the Foreigners' Registration Office may obtain opinions from the university or other institutions approved for training or further education on questions relating to the study requirements.

The residence permit for studying will be issued for a minimum of 1 year and a maximum of 2 years.

If you are participating in an EU or multilateral program with mobility measures, for example the ERASMUS+ program of the European Union, or if you are covered by an agreement between 2 or more higher education institutions, you will be granted a residence permit for at least 2 years.

As a rule, your livelihood and health insurance cover must be guaranteed for the duration of your stay.

The residence permit allows you to work up to 120 days or 240 half days per year. You can also take on a part-time student job.

If you have not yet reached the age of 18, your parents or legal guardians must agree to your stay in Germany.

Rechtsbehelf	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Appeal against the decision of the foreigners authority within one month of notification • Action before the court named in the notice of appeal if the appeal is not granted

completion of a Bachelor's degree

- admission from a state university, a state-recognized university or a comparable educational institution for full-time study has been granted, but admission is subject to the condition that a preparatory college or a comparable institution is attended as a preparatory study measure
- admission has been granted by a state university, a state-recognized university or a comparable educational institution for part-time studies
- a commitment to a preparatory language course without the admission of a higher education institution
- you have been accepted by a company to complete an internship in preparation for your studies
- the permit can also be issued if you have not yet been admitted to a preparatory college or a comparable institution
- living expenses and health insurance cover must generally be secured for the duration of the stay without recourse to public benefits
- the Aliens' Registration Office may obtain the opinion of the university or other institutions approved for training or further education on questions relating to the study requirements
- Residence permits are issued for at least 1 year
- in the case of participation in a union or multilateral program with mobility measures, for example the ERASMUS+ program of the European Union, or if an agreement between 2 or more higher education institutions applies to the applicant, the residence permit will be issued for at least 2 years
- if the applicant has not yet reached the age of 18, the persons entitled to personal care must consent to the stay in Germany
- the residence permit entitles the holder to work for up to 120 days or 240 half days per year. Student part-time employment can be pursued for an unlimited period of time
