The BKM decides on the award based on the jury's recommendation. • The BKM announces the awards at an award ceremony • If you receive an award, the Federal Office of Administration (BVA) is responsible for paying out and processing the award.

Frist	The application deadline for the Cinema Program Award is published on the website of the Federal Government Commissioner for Culture and the Media (BKM). Applications can be submitted until midnight on the relevant day.
