The security personnel check liquids, liquid medicines and liquid special foods using a special control technique. If the safety of a liquid cannot be determined beyond doubt, you may not take this liquid with you in your hand luggage.
Bearbeitungsdauer	The check shall take place during the general aviation security check.
