| Teaser                   | If you have become aware of a criminal offense,<br>regardless of whether you have been harmed yourself<br>or have witnessed a crime, you can file a police report<br>online. This will inform the prosecuting authorities<br>about the event and the course of events.  |
| Volltext                 | You can file a criminal complaint regardless of whether<br>you have been harmed, can testify to a criminal<br>offense or are uninvolved. Fast processing is promoted<br>by selecting the federal state in which the incident took<br>place. You can file a report informally, by telephone,<br>online and at the police station, either anonymously or<br>by providing your contact details. The online report is<br>an additional service. |
|                          | Reporting a criminal offense is the main focus. A<br>distinction is made between different offense groups.<br>If the offense you wish to report is not listed, please<br>select the offense group Other offense.  |
|                          | If you file a report, you are a witness in the criminal<br>proceedings. Regardless of whether you have filed a<br>report online, it may be necessary to summon you to<br>the relevant police station as part of the further<br>processing of the report, for example in order to be<br>able to interview you personally as a witness.   |
|                          | It is also possible to attach photos, receipts or<br>documents to the report as electronic attachments.<br>This option should be used in particular to send<br>evidence (proof of purchase, receipts or pictures of<br>stolen items, damaged items or screenshots of screen<br>content) to the police with the report.  |

| Voraussetzungen  | Anyone who has knowledge of a criminal offense can file a complaint. You do not have to meet any specific requirements.  |
| Kosten           | None   |
| Verfahrensablauf | A report can be submitted online, in writing, by telephone or verbally.  |
|                  | If you wish to submit the advertisement online:  |
|                  | There are several steps involved in filing a report online.  |
|                  | You can file a criminal complaint via the Internet portal.<br>This can involve various offenses.   |
|                  | You call up the Internet Watch via a central URL. The<br>federal state responsible for processing is selected via<br>the location of the incident. After selecting the form for<br>reporting other criminal offenses, you can enter basic<br>information about yourself (e.g. personal details, cell<br>phone number, email address). You can then enter<br>data on the crime scene, the time of the crime, the<br>perpetrator and the event itself. The recording is<br>accompanied by legal instructions (witness or accused<br>person instructions as well as the requirement to file a<br>criminal complaint and the notice of discontinuation). |
|                  | It is possible to submit documents such as proof of purchase, receipts and/or images such as screenshots, images of damage or stolen items with the report.  |
|                  | Once the report has been submitted, you will receive<br>an e-mail with a case number and the contact details of<br>the office responsible for processing the report.   |
|                  | The relevant police department will receive the report<br>and check it. If you report a crime that was committed<br>outside Germany or in another federal state, the<br>prosecuting authority will forward the report to the<br>competent authority.   |

|                                 | Only if there are no grounds for investigation will the<br>investigation be closed by the public prosecutor's<br>office. The chances of success vary depending on the<br>type of offense. Basically, the more information you<br>provide, the better the chances of the police finding<br>the perpetrator.  |
|                                 | Anyone who knowingly and falsely suspects a person is committing a criminal offense. The law provides for a fine or a prison sentence of up to five years.  |
| Bearbeitungsdauer               | After receipt of the online notification, you will receive<br>an email confirmation with a process number. The<br>processing time depends on various factors. It is not<br>possible to set a time limit.  |
| Frist                           | There is no deadline to comply with. However, you<br>should observe the respective limitation periods, as<br>criminal offenses usually expire after a certain period<br>of time.  |

| Hinweise                        | If you file a complaint, you are basically a witness in the<br>criminal proceedings. It may be necessary to summon<br>you to the relevant police station as part of the further<br>processing of your complaint, for example in order to<br>be able to interview you personally as a witness.   |
|                                 | Anyone who is aware of a criminal offense but does<br>not report it may be liable to prosecution. No special<br>formal requirements apply. Caution is advised when it<br>is a suspected criminal offense. Defamation and false<br>accusations are punishable by law, and the person who<br>makes the report must expect legal action to be taken<br>against them. Crimes such as murder, robbery, war<br>crimes and treason must be reported. |
|                                 | A criminal complaint cannot be withdrawn. You should<br>therefore think carefully about whether you want to<br>press charges. According to the principle of legality, the<br>authorities are then obliged to investigate.   |
