Hinweise	Adolescents under 16 years of age are generally only allowed to stay in restaurants, at dance events and in discotheques, if they are not accompanied by a person with custody (parent, guardian), if they are accompanied by a person over 18 years of age who has been entrusted by the parents to accompany and supervise them (person in charge of education). This person can be, for example, an adult sibling or an adult friend. In case of doubt, a corresponding assignment must be proven in writing. Parents usually give their children a note stating that they have been appointed. It should make clear that the assignment includes not only the accompaniment but also the supervision of the minor.

• 16 and 17 years: Up to 24:00 hours, the stay at dance events and in discotheques is permitted without the accompaniment of a person authorized to have custody or a person responsible for the child's
