Teaser

Would you like to work in Germany as a health and paediatric nurse? Then you need a state permit. To do this, you must submit an application and have your foreign professional qualification recognised.

Volltext

The profession of health and paediatric nurse is regulated in Germany. This means that in order to be able to work as a health and paediatric nurse in Germany, you need a state permit. With the permission, you may use the professional title "Health and Paediatric Nurse" or "Health and Paediatric Nurse" and work in the profession.

Even with a professional qualification from the European Union (EU), the European Economic Area (EEA) or Switzerland, you can obtain state permission from the competent authority in Germany. In order to obtain the permit, you must have your foreign professional qualification recognised.

On 1 January 2020, nursing education was reformed in Germany and the new Nursing Professions Act applies. There is a transitional period for the recognition of foreign professional qualifications on the basis of the Nursing Act. Your foreign professional qualification may still be recognised until 31 December 2024 under the old Nursing Act. The competent body will advise you.

In the recognition procedure, the competent body compares your professional qualification with the German professional qualification and checks the equivalence. The equivalence of the professional qualification is an important prerequisite for the granting of state permission. In addition to the equivalence of the professional qualification, you must meet other requirements for the granting of the permit. Further requirements are, for example, sufficient German language skills and health suitability.

If your professional qualification does not come from the EU, EEA or Switzerland, other regulations apply.

You can also apply for the procedure from abroad.

Erforderliche Unterlagen

The competent authority will tell you which documents you need to submit. Important documents are in general:

- Proof of identity (identity card or passport)
- Marriage certificate (if your name has changed due to marriage)
- Curriculum vitae
- Proof of your professional qualification (e.g. certificates, professional certificate)
- Evidence of formal qualifications
- Proof of your relevant professional experience in a profession comparable to health and paediatric nursing
- Proof of further relevant knowledge for working as a health and paediatric nurse
- Information about an application for recognition that has already been submitted. Then indicate to which body you have submitted the application.
- Do you still live or work in a third country, i.e. not in the EU, EEA or Switzerland? Then you may have to prove that you have received a commitment from a health and care institution to work as a nurse in Germany.

You usually hand in these documents later. The competent authority will inform you when to hand in the documents:

- Proof of your personal suitability: extract from the criminal record or certificate of good conduct from your country of origin. The proof must not be more than 3 months old at the time of application.
- Proof of your medical fitness: Medical certificate. The proof must not be more than 3 months old at the time of application.
- Proof of your German language skills: language certificate

The competent authority will inform you which documents you must submit as a simple copy, as a certified copy or in the original.

Voraussetzungen

- You have a comparable professional qualification as a health and paediatric nurse from the EU, EEA or Switzerland.
- You want to work in Germany as a health and paediatric nurse.
- Personal suitability: You are reliable for work as a health and paediatric nurse or health and paediatric nurse and have no criminal record.
- Health suitability: You can work mentally and physically as a health and paediatric nurse or health and paediatric nurse.
- You have German language skills at the required language level. This is usually level B2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

Kosten

The competent authority will inform you about the costs. The costs generally depend on the effort for processing.

In addition, additional costs may arise (for example, for translations, certifications or compensatory measures such as an adaptation period or an aptitude test). These costs vary from person to person.

Verfahrensablauf

****Application****

They submit an application to the competent authority for authorisation to use the professional title of 'health and paediatric nurse' or 'health and paediatric nurse'.

You can submit the application with the documents to the competent authority or send it by post. Do not send originals. Sometimes you can also send the application electronically. The competent authority will inform you.

****Equivalence assessment****

The competent authority will then check whether you meet all the requirements. An important prerequisite is the equivalence of your professional qualification. The competent authority compares your professional qualification with the German professional qualification as a health and paediatric nurse under the Nursing Professions Act or the old Nursing Act. The professional qualification is equivalent if there are no significant differences between your professional qualification and the German professional qualification.

****Possible results of the equivalence assessment****

If your professional qualification is equivalent, your foreign professional qualification will be recognised. The competent authority can confirm the result to you in writing. You still have to meet the other requirements. Then you will receive permission to use the professional title "Health and Paediatric Nurse" or "Health and Paediatric Nurse".

Are there any significant differences between your professional qualification and the German professional qualification? Perhaps you can compensate for the differences through your work experience, other knowledge, skills or competences (lifelong learning). Knowledge, skills and competences must be certified by an authority of the state in which you acquired the knowledge, skills or competences.

However, it may be that the essential differences cannot be compensated by your professional experience, knowledge, skills or competences. In this case, the competent authority will tell you the main differences between your professional qualification and the German professional qualification and why you cannot compensate for these significant differences.

The competent authority will also provide you with compensatory measures that you can take to compensate for the essential differences. If you decide

not to take compensatory measures, your professional qualification will not be recognised and you will not be allowed to work in Germany as a health and paediatric nurse or health and paediatric nurse.

****Compensatory measures****

There are several compensatory measures:

- Adaptation period: The adaptation period lasts a maximum of 3 years.
- Fitness test: The aptitude test examines only those areas in which significant differences have been identified. The aptitude test consists of a practical exam that is combined with an examination interview.

As a rule, you can choose between an adaptation period or an aptitude test.
 If you successfully complete the compensatory measure and meet all other requirements, you will receive permission to use the professional title "Health and Paediatric Nurse" or "Health and Paediatric Nurse".

Bearbeitungsdauer

 The competent authority will inform you if documents are missing. If the documents are complete, the procedure takes a maximum of 3 months.

Frist

There is no deadline. Sometimes documents are still missing in the procedure. The competent authority will then inform you by when you must submit the documents.

Hinweise	<p>**Freedom to provide services**</p> <p>Would you like to offer services in Germany only occasionally and for a short time? Then you usually do not need the state permission. You must meet these requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must be established in another EU, EEA or Swiss country. • You must provide proof of your professional qualifications. • You must report your activity in writing to the competent authority. <p>The competent authority will inform you whether you are authorised to provide services or whether you are required to take an aptitude test.</p> <p>**Equivalence Notice**</p> <p>In the licensing procedure, equivalence is also checked (recognition procedure). You can apply for a separate notification for the result of the examination.</p> <p>**Procedure for ethnic German repatriates**</p> <p>As a Spätaussiedler, you can go through the recognition procedure either according to the laws mentioned here or according to the Federal Expellees Act. You can decide for yourself. The competent body will advise you on which procedure suits you.</p>
