Teaser	Have you completed further training as a specialist dentist abroad? Then you can apply for recognition as a specialist dentist in Germany under certain conditions.
Volltext	The profession of specialist dentist is regulated in Germany. This means that you need a permit if you want to use the designation "specialist dentist" for your specialization in the selected federal state.  With the training as a specialist dentist, you have acquired a medical specialization for your qualification as a dentist abroad. To work as a dentist in Germany, you first need a license to practice medicine or a professional license. In order to be able to work as a specialist dentist in Germany, you must also apply for recognition of your further training as a specialist dentist. This allows you to use the designation "specialist dentist" in your respective specialisation.  Note: You may only use the designation for your specialization if there is a corresponding continuing education designation in Germany as well.  The permission is granted by the competent state dental association after examination of your

	documents and requirements.
Erforderliche Unterlagen	<ul> <li>Curriculum vitae with information on completed further training and professional experience</li> <li>Proof of identity (identity card or passport)</li> <li>Proof of German approbation or professional license and proof of the equivalent level of training</li> <li>Continuing education certificates and certificates of professional practice</li> <li>Written declaration as to whether you have already submitted an application for recognition to another medical association</li> </ul>
	You only need to submit the following documents if your professional qualification was completed before a certain date (deadline). The competent authority will inform you:
	<ul> <li>Certificate</li> <li>or</li> <li>Proof that you have actually and lawfully practised the profession for at least 3 consecutive years during the last 5 years before the certificate is issued.</li> </ul>
	If your documents are not available in German, you must submit German translations of your documents. Translations must be carried out by translators who have been publicly appointed or authorised.
Voraussetzungen	<ul> <li>You must already have a state professional license (approbation) as a dentist or a professional license valid in Germany.</li> <li>If your degree is not automatically recognised, you must prove the equivalence of your professional qualification as a specialist dentist.</li> </ul>

Verfahrensablauf	Before you submit the application, you must already have a license to practice dentistry or a professional license in Germany.

## **Sachverhalt**

You can apply for the recognition of your further training title as a specialist dentist at the responsible state dental association:

- First, submit your application and the required documents to the Dental Association of the state in which you want to work.
- If necessary, you will be asked to submit missing documents.
- The automatic recognition procedure often applies. This means that your professional qualification will be recognised without an individual equivalence test.
- If you started your training before the EU/EEA accession of your training country, you must prove that your professional qualification meets the minimum standards of the EU ("Certificate of Conformity"). This is certified by the competent authority of your training state. If your professional qualification does not meet the minimum standards, you must prove your professional experience. To do this, you must have worked in the profession for 3 consecutive years in the country of origin in the last 5 years before the application.
- If your professional qualification is not automatically recognised, your training must be reviewed individually. The competent authority will then check whether your professional qualification is equivalent. The professional qualification is equivalent if there are no significant differences between your foreign professional qualification and the German professional qualification.
- If your qualification as a specialist dentist is recognised, you can work in the profession in Germany. You will receive a notification.

If significant differences are detected, you will not be certified as equivalent to your qualification as a specialist dentist:

- You will receive a justification.
- You can take an aptitude test to prove the missing knowledge.
- If you successfully pass the aptitude test, you will

	receive the recognition. You may then use the designation "specialist dentist" for your specialisation.
	You can take legal action against the decision of the competent authority within a certain period of time (for example, lodge an objection). The decision is then reviewed. Details can be found in the notice of appeal at the end of your decision. We recommend that you first talk to the competent authority before taking legal action against the decision
Bearbeitungsdauer	Duration (for fixed time): 3 Note for further information on the processing time: You will receive the acknowledgement of receipt within one month of submitting your application. The competent authority will inform you if documents are missing. No later than 3 months after receipt of your complete documents, your application will be decided. The deadline may be extended by one month.
Frist	There are no deadlines.

<ul> <li>Qualifications as a specialist dentist from the European Union (EU), the European Economic Area (EEA) or Switzerland are subject to recognition.</li> <li>Specialist dental degrees from the EU/EEA/Switzerland are often automatically recognised.</li> <li>If the specialist dental qualification is not automatically recognised, the competent authority checks the equivalence of the foreign professional qualification with the German specialist dental qualification.</li> <li>Prerequisite: Approbation as a dentist or a professional license</li> <li>Processing time: within 3 months after receipt of the complete documents; Extension of the period by one month possible.</li> <li>If significant differences are identified, an aptitude test is offered.</li> <li>Responsible: Dental Association of Saxony-Anhalt</li> </ul>
