| Teaser | If you want to provide certain services in other EU countries, you need the EU certificate as proof of your professional experience for some EU countries (e.g. Austria, Belgium, Luxembourg). |
| Volltext | If you wish to provide certain services in an EU member state or establish yourself there, you must, among other things, present the so-called EU certificate in some member states. With this certificate you prove that you provide this service in Germany legally and permanently. If you or your company are a member of a chamber (e.g. Chamber of Crafts), this |
