Teaser	If you want to provide certain services in other EU countries, you will need the EU certificate as proof of your professional experience for some EU countries (e.g. Austria, Belgium, Luxembourg).
Volltext	If you provide certain services in an EU Member State or wish to establish yourself there, you must present the so-called EU certificate in some Member States. With this certificate, you prove that you are legally and permanently providing this service in Germany. In order to demonstrate that the services are provided on a permanent and lawful basis, you must state the specific activity you carry out and its duration. In addition to a description of the company's activities, you must state whether you have worked as a
