Teaser	As a skilled worker with vocational training, you can you can obtain a residence permit to look for a job for a period of six months if you meet certain requirements.
Volltext	You can obtain a residence permit to look for a job for skilled workers if you have completed qualified vocational training in Germany. Qualified vocational training exists if you have completed vocational training in a state-recognized or comparable regulated occupation. The training must have lasted at least two years. If you have completed your vocational training abroad, the equivalence of your qualification with the German qualified vocational training must be determined by the competent recognition body (e.g. the Chamber of Industry or Commerce).
	If you wish to work in a regulated profession, the required professional license must already have been granted or approved when the residence permit for seeking employment is issued. Regulated professions are professional activities that are subject to the possession of certain professional qualifications by law or administrative regulations. Regulated professions in Germany are, for example, doctors, nurses, lawyers, teachers, educators or engineers.
	If you are already resident in Germany, you can obtain a residence permit to look for a job if you were previously in possession of a residence permit for gainful employment or a residence permit for the

	purpose of an EU study-related internship.
	With a residence permit for job-seeking purposes, you can take up a trial job for up to ten hours per week if you are qualified to do so.
	The residence permit is issued for up to six months.
Erforderliche Unterlagen	<ul> <li>Valid passport or passport substitute</li> <li>Visa, if this was required for entry into Germany</li> <li>Current biometric photo</li> <li>Original certificate of successfully completed vocational training</li> <li>In the case of foreign professional qualifications: notification of the equivalence of the foreign professional qualification with a domestic qualified professional qualification, if available</li> <li>For regulated professions: License to practice the profession or confirmation of issue</li> <li>Proof of German language skills</li> <li>Proof of livelihood security (e.g. equity capital, blocked account, declaration of commitment)</li> <li>Proof of your health insurance</li> <li>Current registration certificate</li> </ul>
Voraussetzungen	<ul> <li>You have a recognized and valid passport or passport substitute and - if this was necessary for entry into Germany - an appropriate visa.</li> <li>There is no interest in deporting you.</li> <li>Your stay does not jeopardize or impair the interests of the Federal Republic of Germany.</li> <li>You have</li> <li>qualified vocational training in Germany or</li> <li>an equivalent foreign professional qualification</li> <li>The purpose of your job search is employment as a skilled worker.</li> <li>You have German language skills appropriate to the job you are seeking. As a rule, German language skills of at least level B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages are required.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>If required, you have a license to practice your profession or a confirmation that it has been issued.</li> <li>You can cover your living expenses and health</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Additional fees may apply for the issuance of the residence permit in the form of an electronic residence permit, which can also be used as electronic proof of identity.</li> <li>The time and form of fee collection and payment vary depending on the authority.</li> </ul>
Verfahrensablauf	The procedure is as follows:
	<ul> <li>Depending on the foreigners authority and your request, it may be possible to apply via the Internet. Find out whether your foreigners authority offers electronic application for a residence permit.</li> <li>If you can only apply in person, make an appointment with the immigration office. During the appointment, your application will be accepted and your supporting documents checked (bring these with you to the appointment). Your fingerprints will be taken for the production of an electronic residence permit (eAT card).</li> <li>In the case of an electronic application, the Immigration Office will contact you after receiving your online application to arrange an appointment at the Immigration Office if necessary. During the appointment, your documents will be checked (bring them with you to the appointment) and your fingerprints will be taken for the production of the electronic residence permit (eAT card).</li> <li>If your application is approved, the Foreigners' Registration Office will arrange for the eAT card to be issued.</li> <li>After about six to eight weeks, you can collect the eAT card from the immigration office.</li> </ul>

Hinweise	
Rechtsbehelf	An appeal against a decision by the immigration authority can be lodged with the authority named in the decision within one month of notification of the decision. The appeal may be lodged in writing, in electronic form or for the record.
	If the foreigners authority does not comply with the objection, an action may be brought before the court named in the notice of objection.
Kurztext	<ul> <li>Residence permit for the purpose of gainful employment Issued to qualified skilled workers with vocational training to look for a job</li> <li>Foreigners who have a German qualified professional qualification or a foreign professional qualification equivalent to a German qualified professional qualification can obtain a residence permit for the purpose of seeking employment.</li> <li>The foreign skilled worker must have German</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>language skills that correspond to the desired occupation. As a rule, German language skills of at least level B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages are required.</li> <li>Foreign skilled workers who are already in Germany can obtain a residence permit to look for a job if they were previously in possession of a residence permit for gainful employment or a residence permit for the purpose of an EU study-related internship.</li> <li>The residence permit entitles the holder to carry out a trial employment for up to ten hours per week for which they are qualified.</li> <li>The residence permit is issued for up to six months.</li> <li>Depending on the foreigners authority and your request, you can apply online or in person.</li> <li>A fee is charged for the issue of the residence permit. The time and form of payment vary depending on the authority.</li> <li>Responsible: the foreigners authority responsible for the applicant's place of residence</li> </ul>
