Volltext	<p>Due to a far-reaching harmonization of the fundamental principles of professional law for lawyers in the member states of the EU, the EEA and Switzerland, it is justified to allow lawyers from these countries to work as lawyers in Germany in accordance with the EuRAG.</p> <p>In order to enable the admission procedure required under the principles of the Federal Lawyers' Act (BRAO) and also the professional supervision of such colleagues, the so-called "European lawyers" are admitted to the bar associations under their legal home country designation.</p>
