Teaser	"Interreg VI B Central Europe" is an EU funding program to strengthen transnational cooperation between the countries of Central Europe. Funding is provided for joint projects between transnational partners in selected subject areas.
Volltext	<p>Purpose</p> <p>The Interreg program promotes economic, social and spatial cohesion in Central Europe. Transnational cooperation takes place within the framework of joint projects between public and private decision-makers and stakeholders. Interreg offers them the opportunity to develop ideas and test new ways of working. The partners work together to develop strategies and solutions for their respective core topics and implement them in pilot projects. The international exchange and the different experiences and backgrounds of the project partners offer scope for innovative solutions and the mutual exchange of specialist knowledge. In addition, developments, investments and networks can be created that have an impact beyond the duration of the project.</p> <p>Object</p> <p>The program area functions geographically, economically and culturally as an interface of Europe. At the same time, the area is characterized by strong structural differences. The urban growth areas contrast with large rural, economically weaker regions.</p> <p>Interreg Central Europe focuses on topics that counteract climate change and support intelligent economic growth. Improving transport links to rural</p>

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and peripheral regions and strengthening governance for integrated spatial development also play an important role.

Recipients of funding

Eligible applicants are public and private actors as legal entities based in the "Interreg VI B Central Europe" programme area, e.g. public authorities (federal, state, regional and local authorities), public service providers, research institutions, universities, chambers, associations, business development organizations, companies and non-governmental organizations.

In addition to the German federal states of Baden-Württemberg, Bavaria, Berlin, Brandenburg, Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania, Lower Saxony (Braunschweig region), Saxony, Saxony-Anhalt and Thuringia, the EU member states of Croatia, Austria, Poland, the Slovak Republic, Slovenia, the Czech Republic, Hungary and Northern Italy are also involved.

Eligible costs

Funding is available, for example, for the development and implementation of strategies, concepts, instruments and transnational innovation networks or clusters as well as, to a limited extent, infrastructure and pilot investments.

Eligible costs include personnel and administrative costs, travel expenses, external expertise and services, costs for events and materials and, to a limited extent, investments.

Type and amount of funding

Funding is provided as a grant and the amount depends on the type and scope of the project. The funding rate for Bavarian applicants is up to 80% of the eligible project costs.

The project applied for is supported by at least three

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partners from at least three different countries, of which at least two partners are based in an EU member state. One of these partners takes the lead as "lead partner" and is responsible for the application and coordination of project development and implementation. As a rule, project consortia comprise around 8 to 12 partners from 6 to 10 countries.

Verfahrensablauf

Applications must be submitted online in English on the program's website (see "Online procedure" and "Further links"; detailed information on how to apply can also be found there).

The German contact points and the secretariats provide potential applicants with information and, if necessary, practical advice during the application process. A monitoring committee made up of national and regional representatives of the participating countries of the respective cooperation area decides on the project applications.
