Voraussetzungen	Requirements for the granting of traditional needs-based grants: • Special burdens on the administrative district that go beyond the usual scope and do not exist in the majority of administrative districts, • difficult budgetary situation (to be determined, among other things, on the basis of the free financial margins, amount of reserves, district levy rate, etc.). Requirements for the granting of traditional needs-based grants to rural districts for BKPV reports: • The report must be up-to-date and • the district must have particular budgetary difficulties. • Prerequisites for the granting of stabilization aid: • Existence of financial hardship (assessment as part of an overall assessment, including free financial margins, reserves, indebtedness), • Existence of structural hardship (above-average loss of inhabitants or tax capacity of the municipalities belonging to the district is significantly below the state average), • Proof of willingness to consolidate (e.g. by drawing up or updating and implementing a budget consolidation concept).

Verfahrensablauf	The application for a needs-based allocation and/or stabilization aid must be submitted to the responsible district government in the required digital form. These forward it to the Bavarian State Ministries of Finance

	and Home Affairs and of the Interior, Sport and Integration. These state ministries will review the submitted applications. The Bavarian State Ministries of Finance and Home Affairs and of the Interior, Sport and Integration decide once a year (in autumn) on all applications for a needs-based allocation and/or stabilization aid in accordance with Art. 11 of the Bavarian Financial Equalization Act (BayFAG) in the so-called distribution committee after consulting the municipal umbrella organizations. After the distribution committee, the district governments make the decisions; the grants are usually paid out in the same year.
Bearbeitungsdauer	Decisions are made once a year (in autumn) on all applications for needs-based allocations and stabilization aid; the processing time varies depending on when the application is submitted.
Frist	Applications for needs-based allocations or stabilization aid must be submitted by the deadline set by the Bavarian State Ministry of Finance and Home Affairs. The deadline is announced to the district governments and district administrations in the spring by letter from the Ministry of Finance or on the website of the Bavarian State Ministry of Finance and Home Affairs (see "Further links").
