Teaser	If you live abroad and need a certificate of no capacity to marry abroad, you can apply for this at the Registry Office 1 in Berlin.
Volltext	In some countries you need a certificate of no capacity to marry if you want to get married there as a German citizen. For the issuance of a certificate of capacity to marry for German citizens with residence or habitual abode abroad and without ever having had a residence in Germany, you must apply to the Registry Office 1, Schönstedtstraße 5 in 13357 Berlin. The certificate of capacity to marry is a certificate from the registry office that you are permitted to marry the person named in the certificate of capacity to marry under German law.

	from the birth register or certified copy of the birth certificate from the registry office of your place of birth Residence certificate from the registration authority if applicable: certificate of name change If you have been married/partnered before: Marriage certificate/civil partnership certificate of the last previous marriage with dissolution note
Voraussetzungen	You are at least 18 years old. You have German citizenship. Your residence or habitual abode is abroad and you have never been registered in Germany. They want to get married abroad. The country in which you wish to marry requires you to provide a marriage certificate.
Kosten	Please inquire about the costs of issuing a certificate of capacity to marry at the relevant Registry Office 1 in Berlin.
Verfahrensablauf	You apply for the certificate of capacity to marry in writing or in person at the responsible Registry Office I in Berlin. The Registry Office I in Berlin will review your application and documents. If necessary, it will request additional documents or information from you. The Registry Office I in Berlin will decide on your application.
Bearbeitungsdauer	The processing time depends on the individual case.
Frist	The certificate of no capacity to marry is valid for 6 months after it is issued.
