Verfahrensablauf	 Contact the registry office at your place of residence. Describe your concern. Submit all relevant documents. The registry office will advise you on how your name can be changed. To do this, make an appointment with the registry office. At this appointment, the registrar will take a statement from you about the change of your name. A certificate will then be issued to you.
Bearbeitungsdauer	Approx. four to six weeks.

Hinweise	 You can hire an interpreter at your own expense. The declarations according to § 94 BVFG and Art. 47 EGBGB can only be made once.
