- if applicable, proof of ownership such as invoices, purchase contracts; proof of use for professional purposes (example: vehicle)
- A list of how the property should be distributed in the event of a future divorce. The list must be signed by your spouse or life partner.
- if necessary, evidence as to why items must remain with one of the partners, for example medical certificates.

Voraussetzungen

- You cannot agree on the distribution of the items
- You are a separated married couple or life partner
- the items in dispute are household items
- the item belongs to you personally
- You do not have to give the item to your partner for use, as he or she needs the item to run a separate household
- items belonging jointly to the partners are distributed between them according to the principles of equity

Kosten

- Court costs
- if applicable, legal fees
- both depend on the value of the object

Verfahrensablauf

- An application for the distribution of household items in the event of separation must be submitted to the responsible local court - family court. In any case, it is advisable to consult a lawyer before submitting the application.
- The family court always initially strives for the spouses to reach a mutual agreement on the division of household goods and assets.
- If an amicable solution is not possible, the family court decides at its own discretion. It must take into account the circumstances of the individual case and include the welfare of the children in its considerations.
- In order to facilitate its decision, the court may require each of the spouses to provide detailed information about the items in question.
- The court will usually discuss the matter with the spouses at a hearing and order the spouses to appear in person.
- The court decides on the distribution of household
